What should Paisley have done?

- The children were allowed to take (their father's) car.

Whose car were the children allowed to take?

- The postman must deliver (twenty) parcels before ten.

How many parcels must the postman deliver before ten?

- The postman must (deliver twenty parcels) before ten.

What must the postman do before ten?
