Is (1-7) Castro's Death a Turning Point for Human Rights?

Cuban-Americans **took (2-7)** to the streets of Little Havana on Saturday, saying the passing of one man **could be (2-3-7)** the beginning of hope for the many who **had suffered (2-4-7)** under him.

"This **is (1-7)** a man who **is** deeply **admired (1-6-7)** in the rest of the region for standing up to the United States," **said (2-7)** Eduardo Gamarra

Now it **will be(1-3-7)** up to Raul Castro, who **had** gradually **taken over (2-4-7)** control of the communist island nation starting in 2006, to decide whether his brother's death **marks (1-7)** the end of an era.

Human rights concerns **have** long **shaped (1-4-7)** U.S. relations with Cuba, playing an often crucial role in presidential politics. In the hours after Castro's death, many U.S. lawmakers **took to (2-7)** Twitter to recall Castro's legacy and express the hope his passing **would begin (2-3-7)** a new chapter for the country.
